To fulfill the needs of local hospitals, adult day care centers, and nursing homes, a volunteer group was formed to construct teddy bears, bibs, and wheelchair bags. These items offer comfort and convenience to patients and residents alike. In the summer of 2022, a recycling project was added to our craft station. Volunteers can now assist with our PLARN (plastic yarn) initiative that involves turning single use plastic bags into reusable items for the homeless and saleable items to raise money to support our other programs.
